

Quick Start Guide: Getting involved in the CASC-OR Ontario Time Attack (OTA) Series.

1. Download, read and understand the **OTA rulebook**. <https://time-attack.ca/rules/>
2. **Join an affiliated CASC-OR club:** You must be a member to compete. Those clubs that directly support OTA are:
 - a. Oshawa Motorsport Club (OMSC) <https://www.oshawamotorsportclub.com/>
 - b. Subaru Performance Drivers Association (SPDA) <http://spda-online.ca/content.php>
 - c. Toronto Autosport Club (TAC) <http://www.torontoautosportclub.ca/>
 - d. There are many other clubs. Check out CASC.on.ca for details.

3. You must have track lapping **experience** or have passed an accredited High Performance Driving Education (**HPDE) School**. You have two options to become signed off to compete.
 - a. Forward your track experience or school attendance history to ontariotimeattack@gmail.com You will be advised if your background is adequate to compete safely.
 - b. Enter and pass an accredited HPDE school. OTA offers a well regarded HPDE school for beginners or experienced drivers on May 17, 2017 at the DDT.
 - c. NOTE: There is a separate sign off procedure for those wishing to compete at the CTMP – Grand Prix Track (Mosport) due to its unique nature.
4. Register your car and yourself on the **OTA Car Classification** website <http://ccdb.casc.on.ca/> It is free and lets you interactively classify your car by identifying which modifications if any you have made to the vehicle.
5. **Register for OTA events** on <https://www.motorsportreg.com/> You must first set up an account on the site (which is free to do) and then you can enter the OTA events of your choice including the schools. You will be able to select your vehicle competition number (from those that are available) at that time.
6. You will receive a CASC-OR: **OTA Licence** at your first event once you are signed off to compete. The licence fee is included in the event entry fee.
7. **Arrive** at your first event by 7:30 am and go to the registrar to sign in and receive further instructions. Bring a completed vehicle safety checklist with you. https://time-attack.ca/wp-content/uploads/2017/06/2017_vehicle_self_check_form.pdf
